Registration Cost

If you live in the City limits: \$60.00

If you live outside the City limits: \$65.00

The registration fee will include the cost of a jersey and shorts which the players will keep at season's end.

Please be very careful as you select sizes.

The uniform will be ordered in accordance with your instructions.

Lost or damaged uniforms will be the responsibility of the player.

Opening Day

The season will begin **Monday, December 7, 2020**. Not all teams will play on this day. Each coach will be issued a schedule which will list all of the teams' games of the season. **Each team is guaranteed a ten (10) game season.**

Awards

All Pee Wee players will receive a trophy. **First and second place teams in each division will receive individual trophies.**

Draft Schedule

The draft will occur on the below date at the times listed. If your child is not returning to a previous year's team they should attend the draft to be held at Twin Hills Gym. Every child will be assigned to a team through the draft. **If a child isn't present for the draft his/her name will be drawn out of a hat.** There is no draft for the Pee Wee league.

Team Placement

Your child will be placed on their team based upon age, previous year's team or through the draft. The only exception to this system will be in a case where health is a consideration. **The transportation of your child to practice and games is your responsibility. There will be no special requests for players.**

****Policy Change****

Coach Exclusion Form (yellow sheets) will not be allowed the day of the draft. The form must be completed and returned to the Parks & Recreation main office by close of business the day prior to the draft.

You **may not** re-enter the draft **and** file an exclusion form, if your child is returning to the previous year division.

Uniform Policy

Uniforms **shall** be worn as issued. The only exceptions to this policy will be in the case of a sizing issue, loss or damage. The replacement shirt/jersey or shorts shall be comparable in style and color to the originally issued uniform item. For example: Shirts/jersey's shall be of like style and color. Solid black shorts (**NO** pockets, belt loops, stripes or large logos). If the replacement item is questionable, please contact the Recreation office for approval.

League and team sizes subject to Registration.

Player Participation

Each player is guaranteed playing time in each game. As a normal rule an eligible player is to play **one uninterrupted quarter in each game**. However, players must attend practice to remain eligible for play. If two practices in a row are missed without explanation a player may be benched for one game. Please keep the coach informed of problems which might keep a player from regularly attending practices and games.

Coaches

The selection of coaches for teams is one of the most important duties of the league. Our coaches work on a volunteer basis and receive no payment for their efforts. Your support will be welcomed and appreciated during the season. Keep in mind the only difference between you and your child's coach is that they are able to make the time available to conduct practices and coach during the games.

A meeting will be held on **Tuesday November 10, 2020 5:30 pm** at **Warriors Hall** (inside the Crestview police department). All information needed for the draft will be available as well as discussion regarding rules and league policies.
